The Sound Supervisor is also the primary console operator for all performances.

- Maintain and repair inventory of equipment including in-house sound and video systems, touring sound systems, ClearCom communication systems, house paging systems, and support systems to dressing rooms, green room and other backstage areas.
- Ensure the feeds to VSC's hearing assist system (Loop Listen Technologies) are clear and operational by troubleshooting and recommending repairs/upgrades to keep them functional.
- A1 duties as assigned throughout the season, to include programming and mixing of live audio for all productions.
- Audio Engineer will be expected to assist the Lighting Department on any additional needs as assigned by the Lighting and Sound Supervisor.
